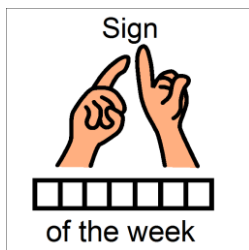


When we show we think about other people's feelings, we are **polite**.

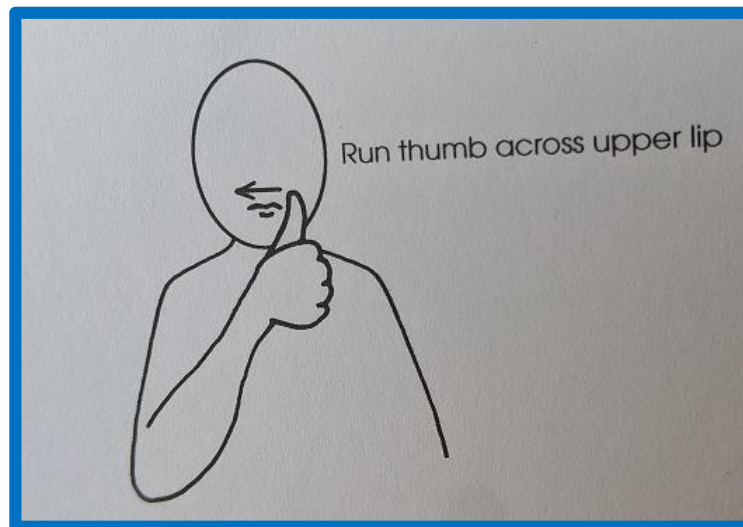

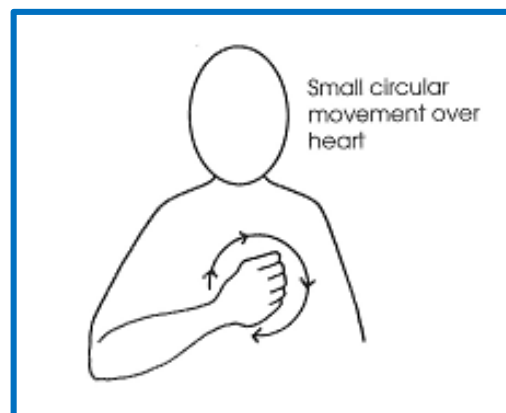
When we are **polite**, 'please', 'thank you', 'sorry' and 'excuse me' are things we might say.



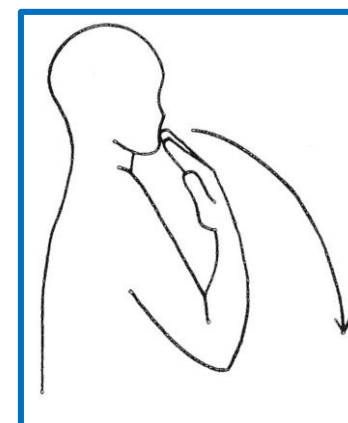

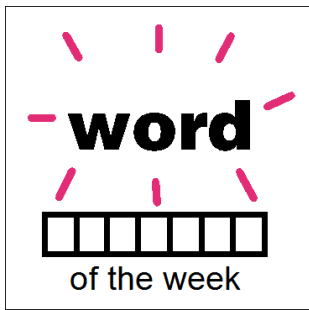


When we **remember**, we think about things that have happened in the past.

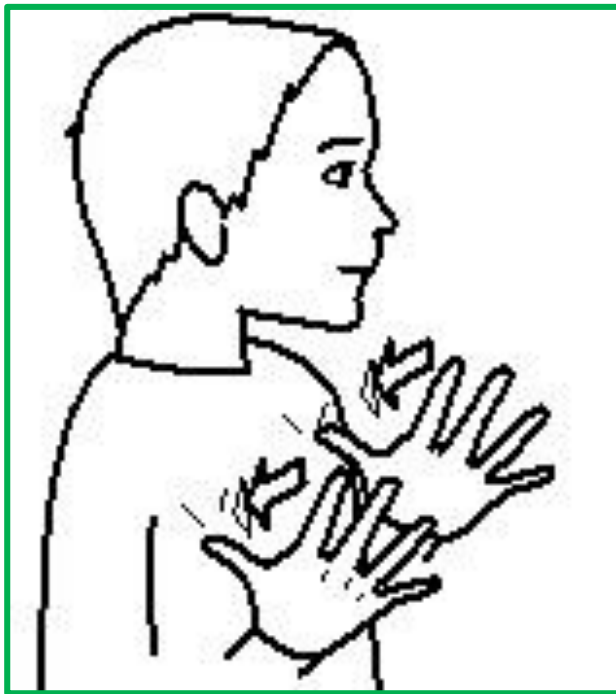
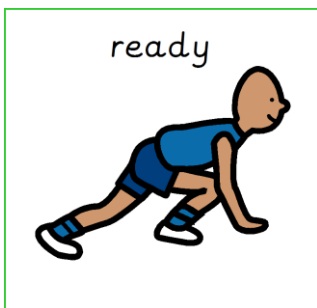
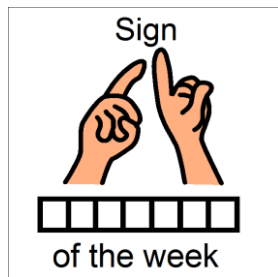




When we **prepare**, we get ready for something that is going to happen.
