## festive

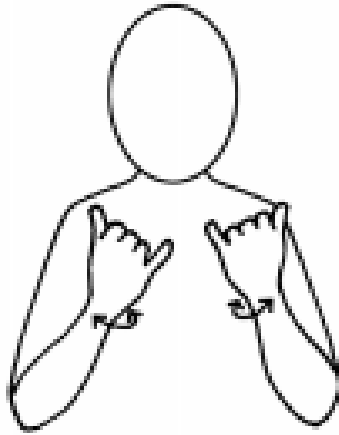
When somewhere looks *festive*, it looks like we are *celebrating*.

We often hear the word '*festive*' about birthday, Christmas, Diwali and Eid decorations and celebrations.





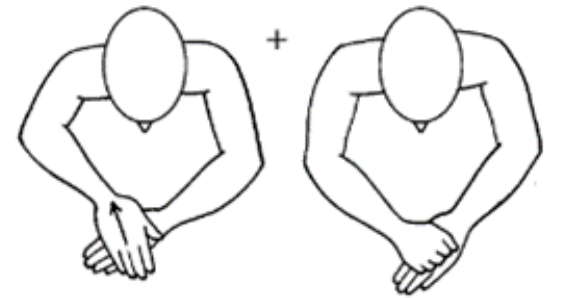
